MESSAGE FROM OUR CHAPLAIN

Dear Bishop McGuinness Families,

I hope this note finds all of you well, and that you had a restful and blessed Thanksgiving holiday. In just a few more weeks, the semester will be over, and we will be celebrating Our Lord's birth at Christmas.

In these weeks leading up to Christmas, the Church celebrates a



special liturgical season: the season of Advent. In the midst of all the hustle and bustle of the holiday season, I think it can be easy to put Advent on the back burner, but to do so is to miss out on a wonderful opportunity to grow closer to Our Lord.

So, what is Advent? Advent is essentially a time of preparation: preparing our hearts for the coming of Jesus at Christmas. As we go through the year, it is very easy for us to become distracted by the business of daily life, and Advent provides us a time to refocus and prepare ourselves spiritually for Christmas.

During the season of Advent, there are two main ways we can go about this preparation: drawing nearer to Our Lord, and removing obstacles in our relationship with Him. On a practical level, some ways we can draw nearer to Our Lord are: prayer, making visits to the church, reading Scripture, and receiving the sacraments, especially the Eucharist and Confession. In terms of removing obstacles, this can mean going to Confession if we haven't been in a while, and also seeking to detach ourselves from worldly things that take up too much space in our hearts: things like food and drink, television, social media, video games, etc., in order to make more room in our hearts for Jesus. If we choose to engage in some of these practices, we will be doing ourselves an incredible favor, and preparing ourselves well to experience the joy of Christmas. You will all be in my prayers during this Advent season, and I hope you all have a blessed and joyful Christmas.



We are so excited to meet with you and your student to officially begin the college discussion. We will cover senior course selection, picking a good fit school, navigating Naviance and steps moving forward.



Immunization Records

Each student must have a current, COMPLETE Immunization Record on file. (PLEASE INCLUDE ALL PAGES OF THE RECORD)

Rising Seniors, Class of 2025, are required to have two (2) doses of the Meningococcal conjugate.

All new students (rising Freshmen and Transfer Students) must also have an Immunization Record on file.

Please *DO NOT* upload the immunization records to FinalForms.

Driver Eligibility Information

When your student is ready to go to the DMV to get his/her permit, a parent will need to call The School Office to request an official transcript and Driver Eligibility Certificate.

Please allow 48 hours notice to process any transcript requests.

A parent must bring the student's Driver's Ed Completion Certificate to The School Office and sign the Driver Eligibility Certificate. The Driver Eligibility Form is good for 30 daysonce it has been signed. Please keep this in mind when making plans to go to the DMV.

The DMV is now requiring official transcripts as a proof of residency. Please contact the front office at 336-564-1010 to make this request.

Driver's Ed is offered through the NC Driving School. You can visit www.ncdrivingschool.com for instructions to sign up. North Carolina requires that Driver's Ed be taken in the county of the high school. (i.e. Bishop McGuinness is in Forsyth county. If you live in Guilford county, you must take Driver's Ed in Forsyth county.) You can sign up on their website at one of the public high schools. You may choose to do private Driver's Ed, which may be completed in any county.
